What is Canva? Canva is a web-based graphic design platform that allows users to create professional-quality designs using a simple drag-and-drop interface. It offers thousands of templates, images, and design elements to help you bring your vision to life with minimal effort. Best of all, it's available for free, with premium options for added features. Getting Started with Canva

1. Sign Up & Log In

• Visit <u>www.canva.com</u> and create an account using your email or Google/Facebook login.

2. Exploring the Dashboard

• The homepage provides options for different design types such as social media posts, presentations, and marketing materials.

3. Choosing a Template

 Canva offers pre-designed templates for various needs. You can start with a blank canvas or customize an existing design.

4. Using Design Elements

- Drag and drop images, text, icons, and shapes onto your canvas.
- Experiment with fonts, colors, and layouts to match your vision.

5. Saving and Downloading Your Design

- Once your design is complete, click 'Download' and choose your preferred format (PNG, JPG, PDF, etc.). If sending off to a printer then do use the PDF Print setting.
- Canva also allows you to share directly to social media platforms or collaborate with others.
- You can also send a link to your design if you want to share it with another person

Pro Tips for Better Designs

- **Keep it Simple** Avoid overcrowding your design with too many elements. Stick to essential details to keep it clean and professional.
- Use a Consistent Color Palette Choose a set of complementary colors that align with your theme or brand to ensure a cohesive look.
- Leverage White Space Proper spacing makes your design more readable and visually appealing.
- **Select Readable Fonts** Stick to a maximum of two or three fonts, ensuring they are easy to read and complement each other.
- Use High-Quality Images Blurry or pixelated images can diminish the impact of your design. Utilize Canva's extensive image library or upload high-resolution pictures.
- Align and Balance Elements Make sure text and images are properly aligned for a polished look. Use Canva's built-in grid and alignment tools to achieve balance.
- **Incorporate Visual Hierarchy** Highlight the most important elements of your design using bold fonts, larger sizes, or contrasting colors to guide the viewer's focus.
- Take Advantage of Canva's Features Experiment with Canva's effects, animations, and filters to make your designs stand out.
- **Optimize for Different Formats** When designing for different platforms, adjust the size and layout accordingly to ensure your content looks great on all devices.
- Use the Accessibility tool under File to check your designs for ease of reading

Another few tips:

To stay organised, I would suggest that you make folders to keep your designs where you can access them easily. Otherwise your designs are added to the recent designs list and you may spend ages tracking down the one you want.

Take your own photos: if you feel limited by the photos on Canva, take your own and upload them. I use my phone or digital camera to take photos that I can use as backgrounds for quotes. I do not like having my own photo taken, but do follow any guidelines from your own organisation for what you can show.

Use correct wording on your posts: don't be drawn into using words that don't comply with the words advised by your organisation. Consult any guidelines available. Don't forget that anything you post can be shared by others and may be picked up by someone that does not agree with your wording.

Don't forget to put your name on your posts: irritatingly quite a lot of people will not think twice about copying your design and pretend it's their own. I've had some posts copied, cropped and used by other people like they made it. So think of ways in your design that makes it harder to crop.

Start with free Canva version: I would you to start with the free version and have a play with that to see if it is enough for you. Then take advantage of the canva pro offer of a month for free to see if upgrading will make you use it more?
